

# Call for Special Issue Proposals - Anuário Antropológico 2023

The Anuário Antropológico (AA) – the journal published by the Graduate Program in Social Anthropology at Universidade de Brasília – is receiving proposals of Special Issues that will be published in two numbers of its 2023 volume. The deadline of the submission is March 30<sup>th</sup>, 2022

Proposals in Portuguese, English, French and Spanish will be accepted.

Proposals should be sent to the journal's e-mail (revista.anuario.antropologico@gmail.com), with the following information and responding certain requirements.

### About the editors:

I - Both must be PhDs in social anthropology or work in that field (having received a PhD from a related academic discipline but working in a social anthropology Institution such as departments, museums, research institutes, and so forth) and linked to institutions in different units of the Brazilian federation or countries;

II- In case they are from a country other than Brazil, both guest editors can be from the same country, but they still need to be from different institutions.

### About the proposal:

The proposal must have the following information:

- I Title of the special issue proposed, with justification of its relevance. It is expected that the justification contains considerations about the contribution of the issue to the existing literature on the subject;
- II Summary and abstracts of the articles that will compose the special issue, with institutional identification of their authors. Each abstract must have up to 150 words. The special issue shall bring together articles by researchers from different states (in Brazil) and/or countries;
- III The special issue shall be made up of between 4 and 7 articles, excluding introduction, which shall observe the style rules of the journal;
- IV The dossier may be composed of articles in different languages, namely Portuguese, English, Spanish and French;
- V- The proposal must be in word format and contain a maximum of 2 thousand words;
- VI Curriculum vitae of the editors.



#### About the editorial flow:

- I The articles received will go through screening by the proponents of the dossiers, herein called guest editors;
- II The guest editors must indicate at least two reviewers for each of the articles composing the special issue proposal, observing criteria of institutional, regional and national diversity, besides functional diversity (reviewers in the beginning and end of their careers);
- III The AA's secretariat will be responsible for sending the articles to the reviewers and for communicating with the authors about the evaluation of their texts;
- IV The peer reviews will be sent to the guest editors at the same time as they are sent to the authors. The authors will have up to 30 days to submit a new version of their contributions.
- V The AA Editorial Committee is responsible for the final evaluation of the proposed articles, verifying whether they satisfactorily meet the requirements of the reviewers and the journal's quality standards. In unsatisfactory cases, publication will be vetoed;
- VI The introduction text for the special issue is the responsibility of the guest editors. In addition to presenting the texts that make up the dossier, the introduction should provide reflections on the state of the art of the theme and justify the relevance and originality of the dossier.
- VII The editors cannot participate as authors or co-authors of the articles included in the dossier.

## **Deadlines**

- I The proposal must be sent to the Journal's e-mail (revista.anuario.antropologico@gmail.com) by March 30<sup>th</sup>, 2022.
- II The results will be announced on the Journal's website and in an e-mail sent to the proponents until April 30th, 2022.
- III The selected special issues must be sent to the journal on the following dates:

July 30<sup>th</sup>, 2022 – Special Issue to be published in January 2023;

October 30<sup>th</sup>, 2022 – Special Issue to be published in May 2023.
