Proposta:

A proposta do curso é analisar os caminhos abertos pelas discussões da antropologia na segunda metade do século XX e seus possíveis aproveitamentos contemporâneos. O programa está baseado, principalmente, na leitura de monografias consolidadas que permitem o contato com temas de relevante impacto na constituição do campo disciplinar da antropologia. A partir da discussão das obras específicas bem como dos diálogos que as mesmas estabelecem entre si e com questões teóricas e metodológicas que as transcendem, objetiva-se lidar com a pluralidade epistemológica da disciplina e suas capacidades de produção de conhecimento.

Dinâmica das aulas:

O curso se baseia em discussão dos textos em sala de aula. A cada aula um(a) alun@ ficará responsável por trazer informações a respeito da trajetória do autor a ser discutido e mais dois(duas) alun@s trarão questões por escrito para alimentar o debate. À professora caberá situar a discussão no quadro teórico mais amplo da antropologia e direcionar os debates, bem como esclarecer questões específicas referentes aos livros/artigos discutidos.

Avaliação

A participação nos debates em sala de aula (incluindo os pequenos textos para alimentar as discussões) compreenderá 20% da avaliação final. Ao longo do semestre cada alun@ entregará duas resenhas de livros discutidos em aula (20% cada resenha, de 3 a 5 páginas). Ao final do semestre haverá uma prova teórica a ser realizada em casa (40%).
